Week 5

'Meet the Garden Tools'

Learning Objectives:

- Students will be introduced to a range of common garden tools and learn about their uses.

Learning Outcomes:

- To identify and describe the correct use and potential dangers of a range of garden tools

Challenge: Identify the dangers inherent in the use of the tools.

Differentiation: The teaching assistant to support the students to complete the activity sheets and supervise them when they are using the tools.

AFL: Reference to scheme of work.

Development of Skills/Cross Curricular LITERACY/COMMUNICATION

Completion of worksheets, class discussion.

PSHE

Health and safety awareness .

ENTERPRISE

Team work and group skills.

STARTER ACTIVITY.

Register the students and share the learning objectives with them.

Establish the students level of prior knowledge of garden tools and their potential dangers through an open class discussion. Recapitulate on the importance of PPE and other safety equipment.

MAIN PART OF LESSON.

Indoor Activity: Demonstrate the use of each of the garden tools, with a brief discussion about their application. Students to be given time to handle and examine the individual tools independently and safely.

Outdoor Activity: Tool use simulated, demonstration and explanation by teacher.

Indoor/Outdoor Activity: Completion of 'Garden Tools' sheet by students, highlighting tool uses and the possible dangers that can ensue if a tool is not used appropriately.

PLENARY

Students to correctly name and describe the use and dangers of various tools. Review answers through a group discussion.

Extension Task: Complete the 'Tool Identification' word search.

Risk Assessment: Teacher in charge to ensure all correct and appropriate risk assessments are carried out to ensure the health and safety of all of the students in the group.
